





Drinking communal bowls of rum punch is a shipboard tradition in the Tropics that dates back to the 1600s. We tasked James Beard awardwinning drinks historian David Wondrich, who literally wrote the book on Punch, to come up with just the sort of thing that was drunk onboard the sailing frigates of the real pirates of the Caribbean.
